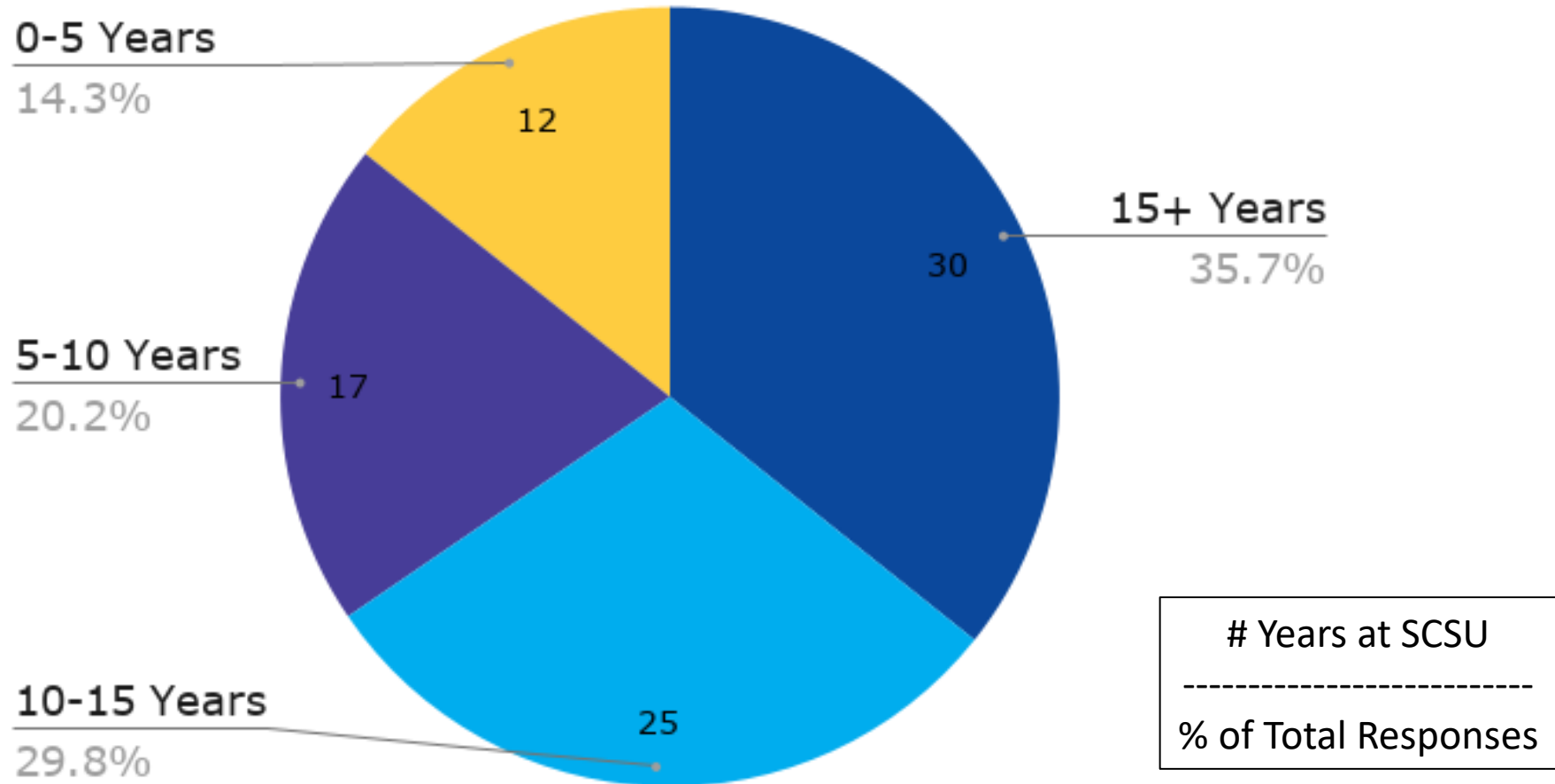

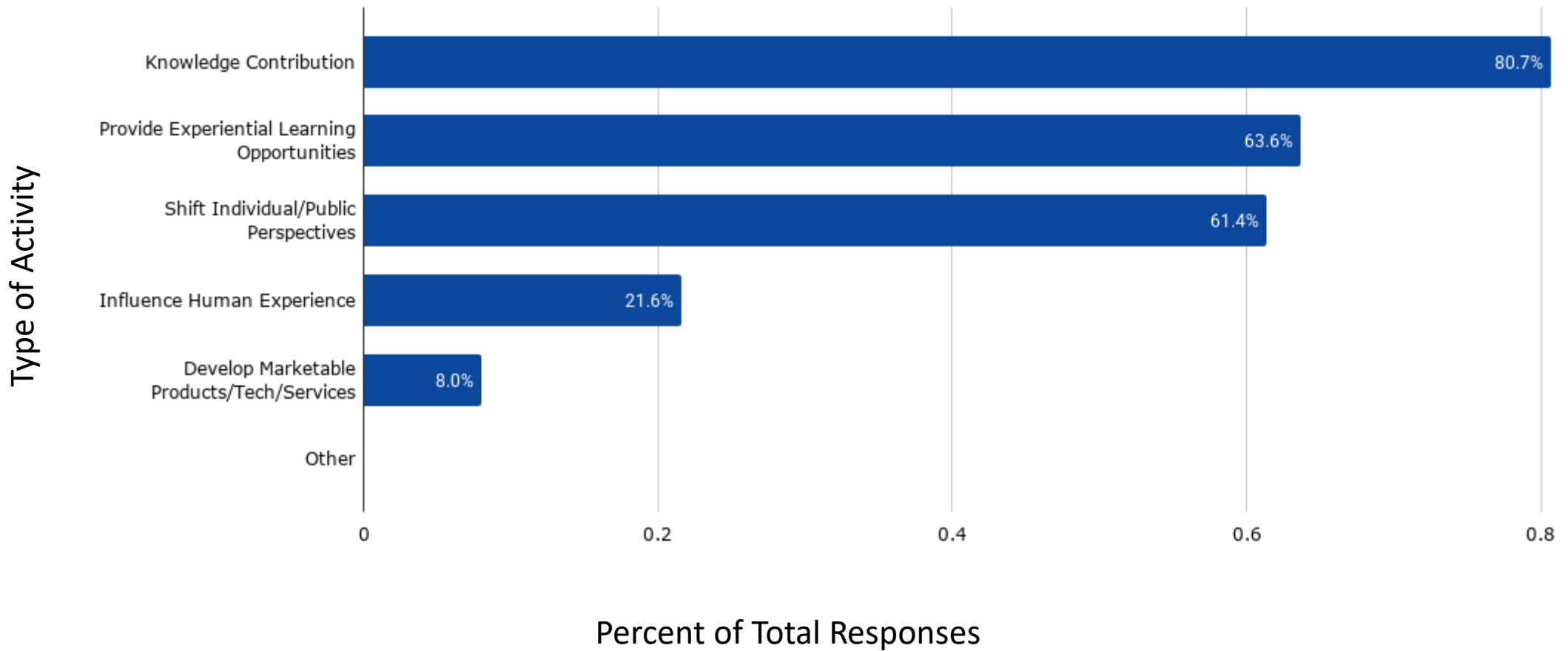

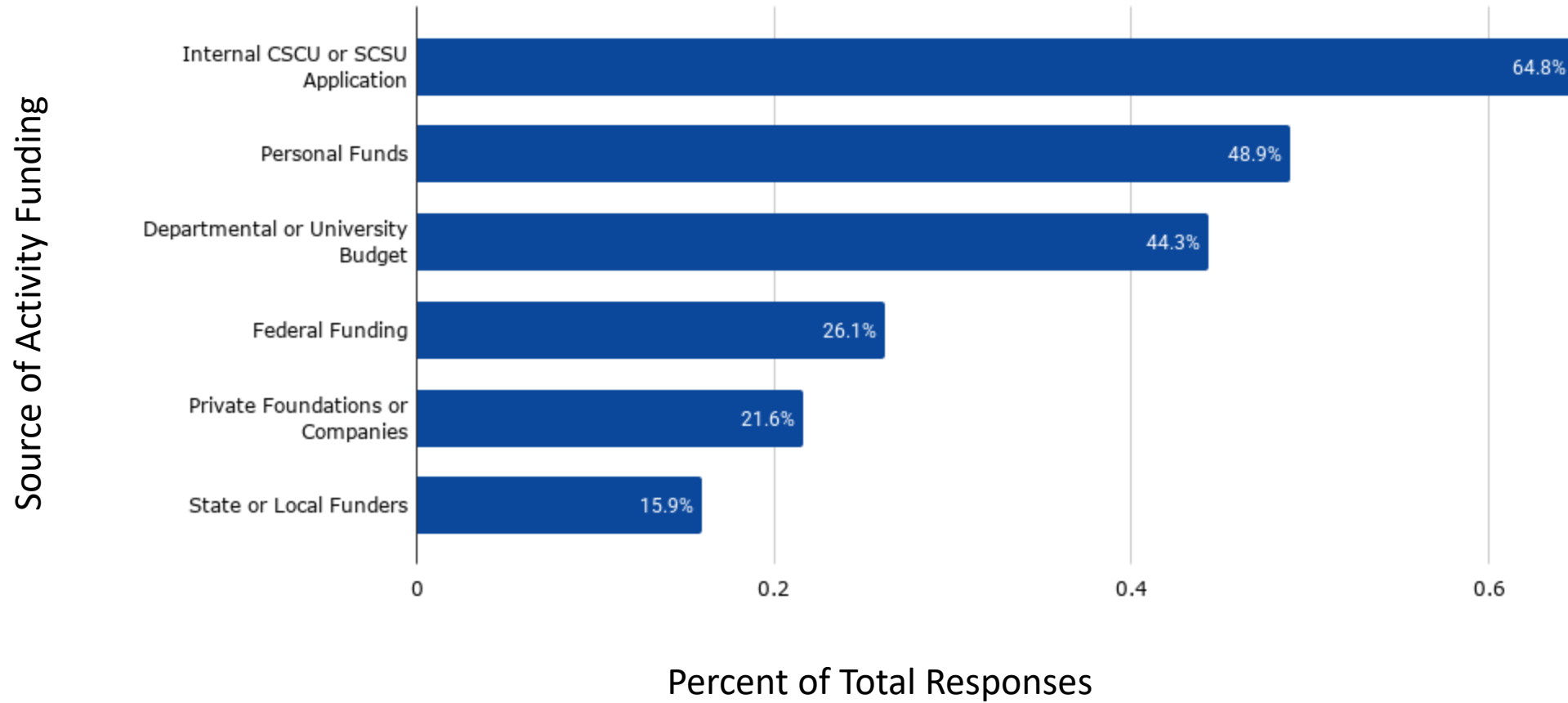
Demographics



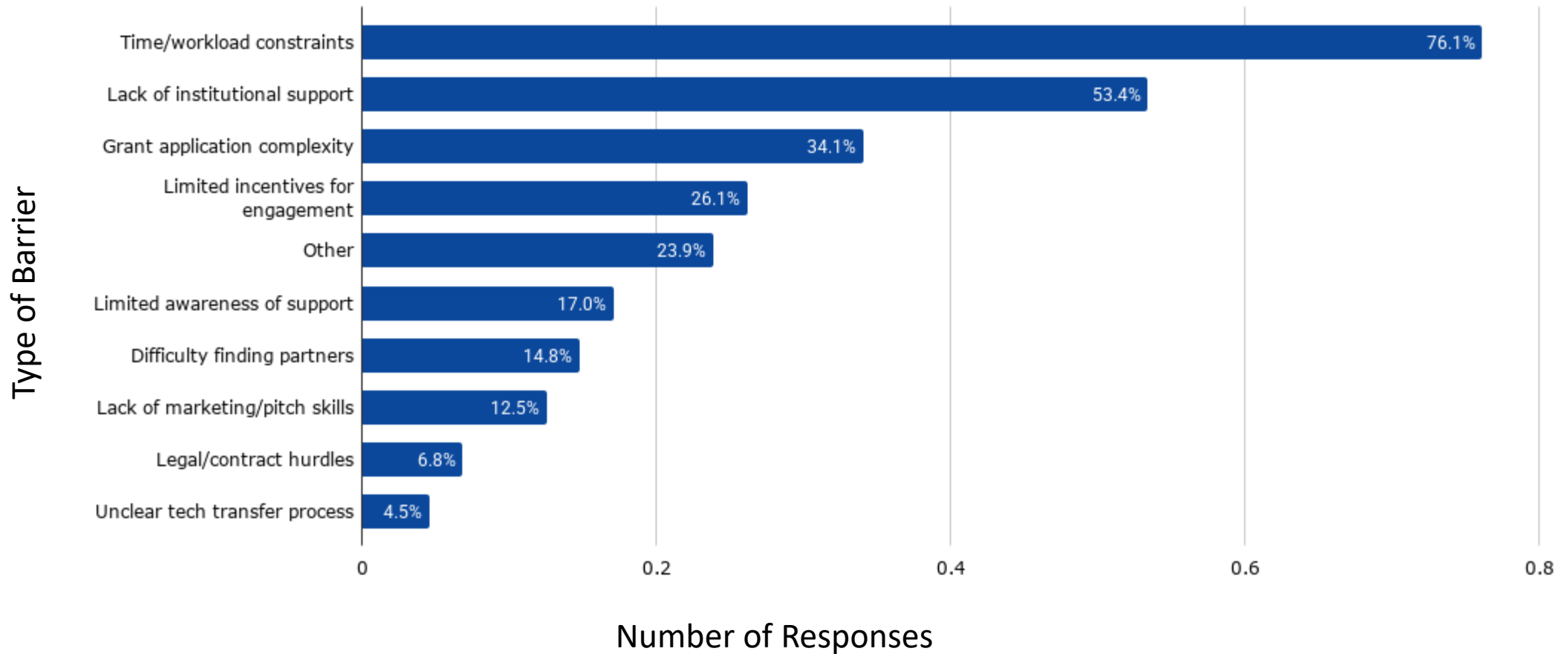
Intent of Activities



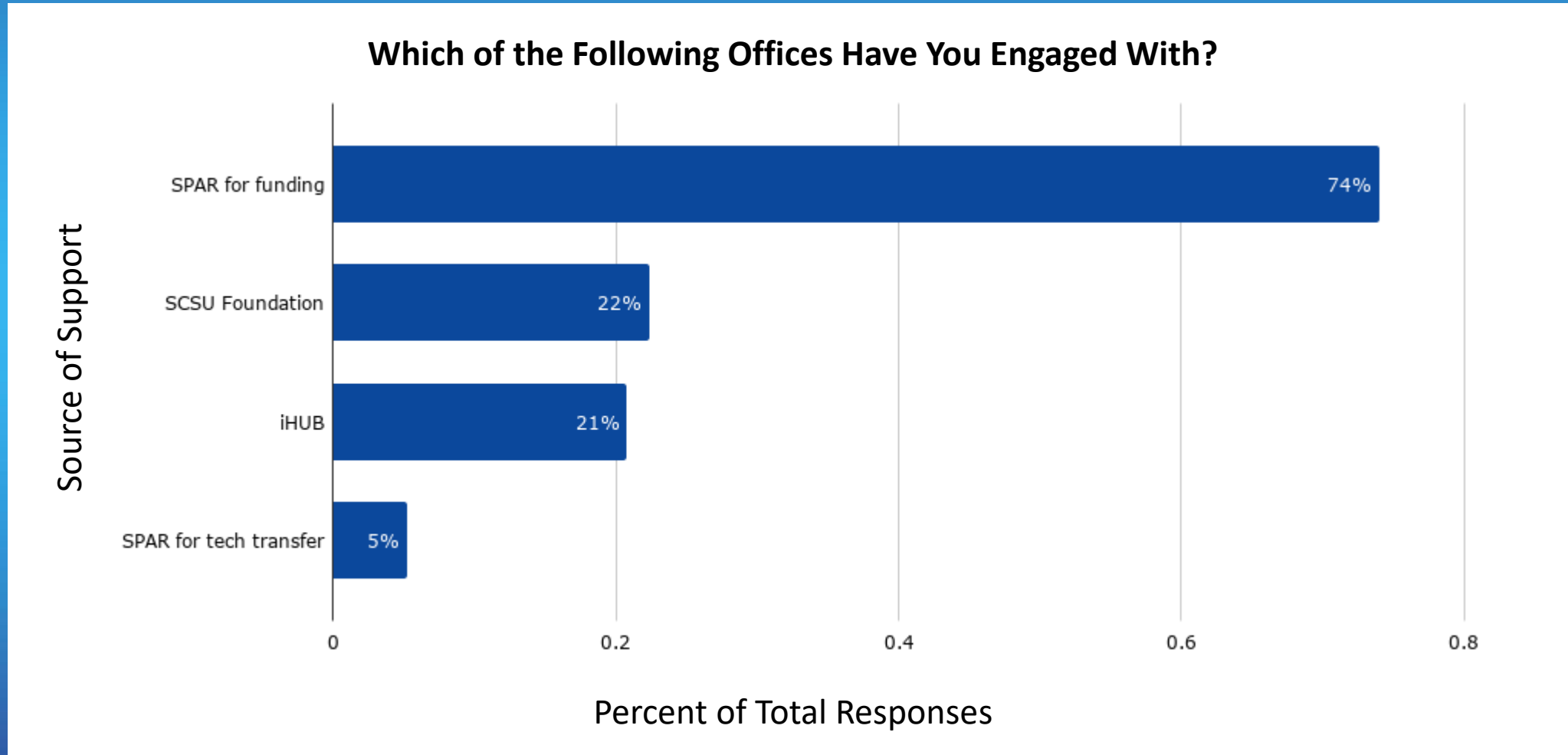

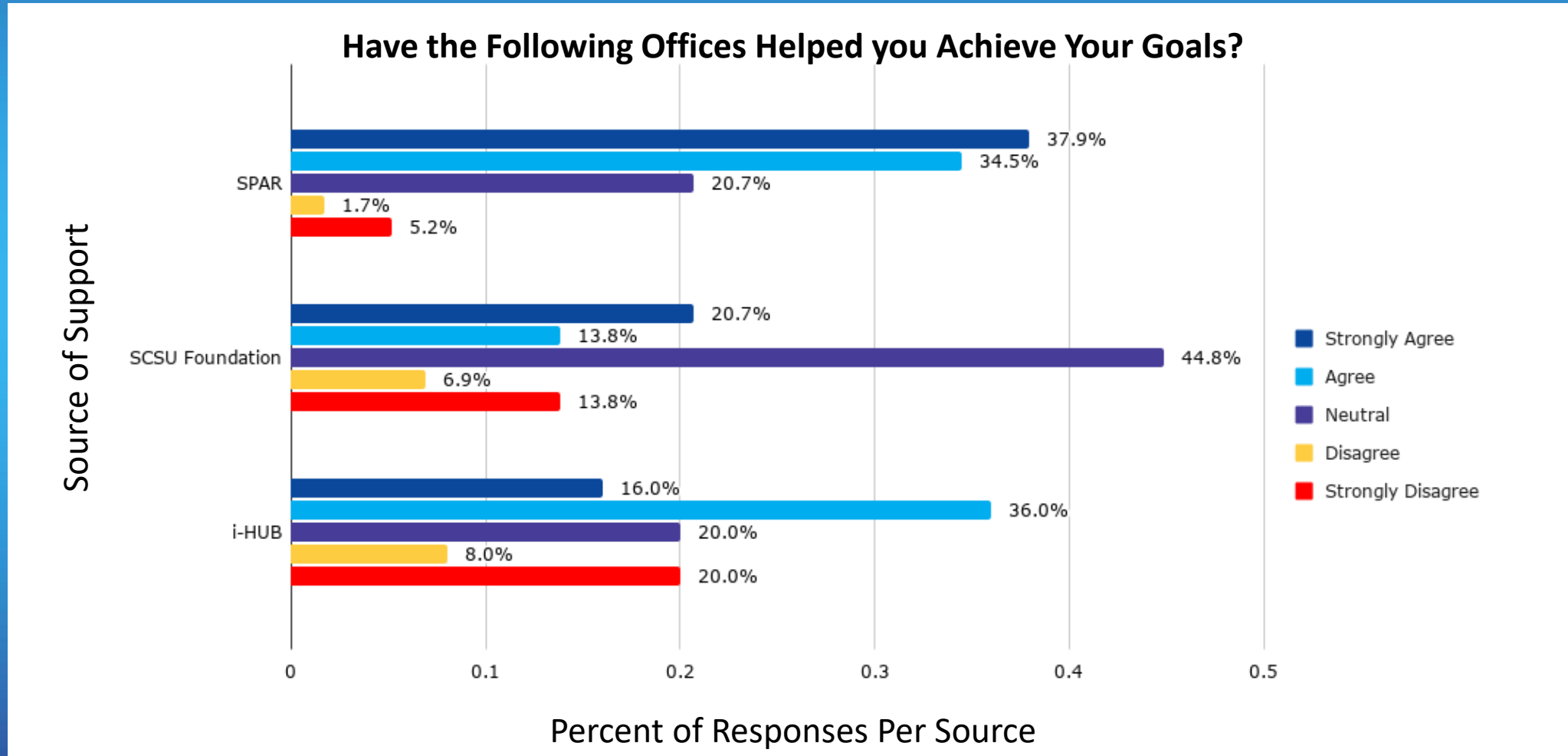

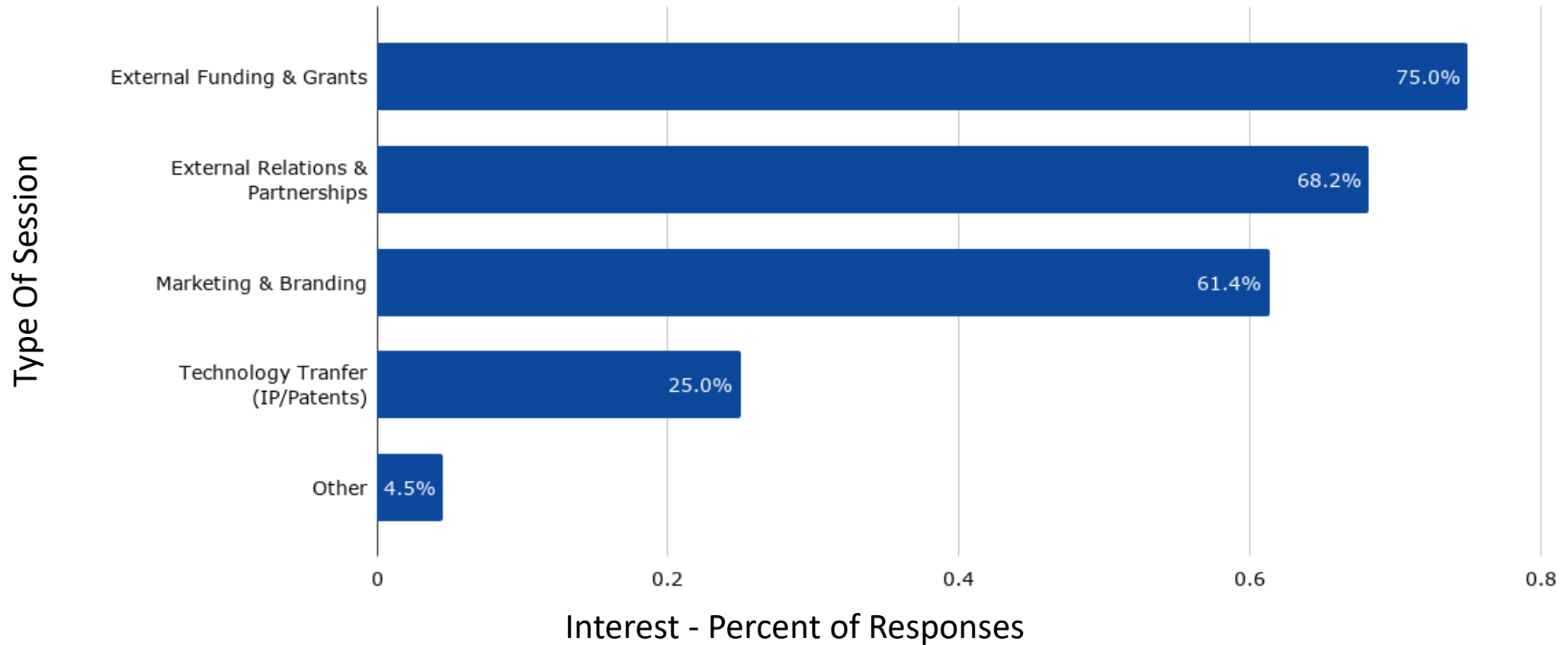
